



Commingled Recycling

Now combine paper, plastic, glass, cardboard, aluminum and glass in ONE container without taking time to separate. Below are a few helpful guidelines:

Plastic

- Plastic items are recyclable if there are numbers 1-7 on the container (normally found on the base)
- Please be sure containers are EMPTY as much as possible

Glass

- Colored glass

Cardboard

- Corrugated boxes (Must be FLATTENED)

Paper Products

- All white & colored paper/copy paper with any color ink
- Computer paper, blueprints, phone books
- Sticky Notes, Index cards
- Envelopes (if it has a clear window, the clear material must be removed)
- FAX paper
- Notebook paper, personal stationary, posters
- Pamphlets and brochures (OK if glossy)
- Paperback books, magazines with glue or stapled binding
- Construction paper, brown craft paper or envelopes
- Newspaper & newspaper insert ads
- Paper plates, paper towels, napkins which are TOTALLY clean
- Phonebooks

Not recyclable: facial tissues, photographs, photography paper, copy paper wrappings from reams, or any paper coated with a waxy material

Aluminum

- Aluminum cans
- Not recyclable:** paper clips, staples, foil paper, and foil wrappers, foil linings inside food containers/boxes
